



Learning Overview/Curriculum MAP Key Stage 1: Years 1,2 Theme: Little Italy

## **HISTORY**

Yr 2: An overview of The Romans – finding out about people and events in other times. Comparing similarities and differences, then and now.

### **GEOGRAPHY**

Yr1/2: Exploring and comparing maps and flags of the UK and Italy. Identifying similarities and differences using picture books and the internet.

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What do Christians believe God is like? (Y1)
Why does Christmas matter to Christians? (Y1 / 2)
Who is a Muslim and how do they live? (Y2)

## **LITERACY**

Yr1: **The Little Red Hen** – rehearsing and writing sentences that make sense. Using capital letters and full stops appropriately.

Yr2: The Little Red Hen Makes a Pizza – spelling tricky words correctly and varying conjunctions to connect sentences.

Writing for a purpose – recipes, instructions.

Development through song lyrics and artwork.

# PHYSICAL EDUCATION, DRAMA AND DANCE

Ball skills – ball retrieval.

Watch and learn a traditional
Italian dance – The Tarantella.

### **MATHS**

Yr 1: Place value – 1 more, 1 less
Read, write and recognise numbers to
100. Addition and subtraction – number
bonds and facts within 20.
Identifying 2D and 3D shapes.
Describe position, direction and
movement.

Yr2: Recognise the place value of each digit in a two digit number.
Add and subtract two 2 digit numbers. Identify and describe properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

### **SCIENCE**

Identify, name and sort a variety of materials. Performing simple tests and experiments, making predictions and observations.

Observe seasonal changes across the four seasons. Begin to understand how day length varies.

## **COMPUTING**

To create a digital picture of the Italian flag.

Introduce and build on knowledge of coding through use of BeeBots – Little Red Hen map.

## **DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY**

Design, make and evaluate a pizza/bread/ice-cream.
