PPA Every week our teachers are entitled to 10% non-class based time to plan, prepare and assess. In Key Stage 2 this happens on a Wednesday pm. This year we are introducing a four group rotation (Y3,4,5 and 6) Each week one group will go to Tarka Gym with a member of staff for a gymnastics/PE session. This is an amazing opportunity for them; we have subsidized the cost as we do with swimming but still need a parental contribution to meet transport costs. Our first group to try it are Year 6.
