Pre-school Build

You may be aware that the Governors have been working hard over the last few years to plan the future of our thriving pre-school. Since the Methodist church ceased to meet the future has been uncertain. The Governors want to make sure that our provision is sustainable so that we can continue to take children from the age of two as part of our school. We have been raising money through fund raising, donations, lettings, PTFA and other income. Since gaining planning permission earlier this year we have been able to source a builder and now have enough funds to start the build. It is due to start over the summer holidays. When it will be finished is unknown, we still need to raise more money to complete the project but we have enough to get to a water tight stage.

We will ensure that the build will not disrupt our daily routines and that we will still have a spacious and safe Codden classroom for September.

The governors are excited at the prospect of continuing our pre-school provision with all the benefits of having the children and staff based on our site.

We will keep you updated in the new term.
