

### Tarka Class - Home learning week ending 14<sup>th</sup> January

We have continued our learning on The Three Little Pigs, retelling the story using actions and expression. We have been learning when to use a full stop and when to use an exclamation mark at the end of sentences from the story. The children practiced using capital letters for names of people/characters.

In maths, we have practised counting in twos and tens using 2p and 10p coins. We have solved problems involving money and decided which coins to use to match a given amount.

In Science, we have started our learning about **materials**. The children loved building houses out of straw, sticks and bricks and investigating which materials the Big Bad Wolf could blow down. We simulated the Big Bad Wolf by using a hairdryer!

From this term, I will be out of class each Thursday morning to support an Early Careers Teacher at Langtree school. Ms Burnell will be teaching Tarka class every Thursday morning, delivering the ICT and Computing curriculum. The children loved using the laptops again this week and have been learning how to use a keyboard and log on.

**Home learning:** To support our Science learning, think about the materials that objects are made from around your house (wood, plastic, metal, brick, glass etc).

**Reading:** Please keep up with your reading practice at home. We are really seeing a difference in the children who read 4 or more times a week 😊
