
## What to do if you receive a Covid19 positive test result during the holidays



School do NOT need to be contacted if you are self-isolating over the Christmas holidays unless you receive a positive C19 test result (as above)

If you are self-isolating and this means your child will not be returning to school on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January please email <a href="mailto:admin@bishopstawton-primary.org">admin@bishopstawton-primary.org</a> to let us know

ONLY Positive C19 Test result emails will be responded to over the Christmas Holidays.

This mail box will not be checked after 12pm on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2020 until staff return to school on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

Please continue to keep yourselves and others safe if you have to self-isolate over the Christmas Holidays and we look forward to seeing all the children on Monday 4<sup>th</sup>January 2021.

Self-isolation is when you do not leave your home.

It is a legal requirement to self-isolate if you test positive or are told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace. You could be fined if you do not self-isolate.
