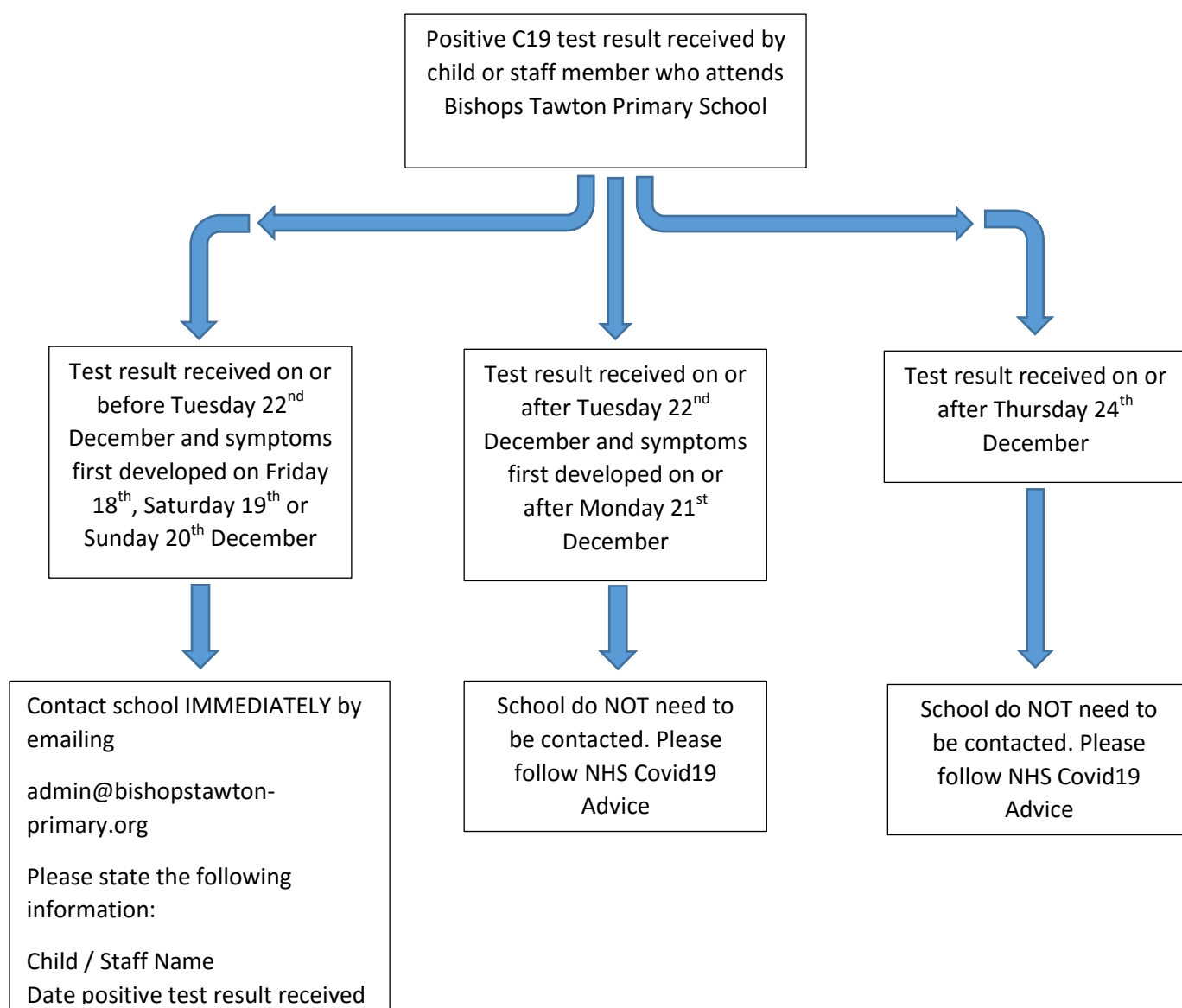


What to do if you receive a Covid19 positive test result during the holidays



School do NOT need to be contacted if you are self-isolating over the Christmas holidays unless you receive a positive C19 test result (as above)

If you are self-isolating and this means your child will not be returning to school on Monday 4th January please email admin@bishopstawton-primary.org to let us know

ONLY Positive C19 Test result emails will be responded to over the Christmas Holidays.

This mail box will not be checked after 12pm on Wednesday 23rd December 2020 until staff return to school on Monday 4th January 2021.

Please continue to keep yourselves and others safe if you have to self-isolate over the Christmas Holidays and we look forward to seeing all the children on Monday 4th January 2021.

Self-isolation is when you do not leave your home.

It is a legal requirement to self-isolate if you test positive or are told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace. You could be fined if you do not self-isolate.
