This week we have:

- Learnt the sounds **ck**, **e** and the tricky word **I** in phonics and practised blending and segmenting two and three sounds to read and spell words.
- Played eye spy, using a tray of objects and focussing on the sounds we've learnt so far.
- Continued to focus on number 6 in maths, counting 6 objects from a larger group and looking at how 6 can be split into 3 and 3 or 4 and 2.
- Had a go at ordering numbers to 10, playing a number hunt game and placing the number on a number line.
