

#### Sickness Policy

It can be upsetting when children seem fine but are unable to attend school due to sickness but please note if your child has been unwell at home with sickness and/or diarrhoea please keep your child off school for a minimum of 48 hours following the last episode of illness.

If your child is sick and/or has diarrhoea at school we will contact you to collect your child as soon as possible. Your child should then remain off school for a minimum 48 hour period following the last episode of illness. When your child returns to school we do ask that they are well enough to be eating their normal diet.

Eye/skins infections should be treated and cleared before returning back to school. Thank you.
