As part of our topic learning, we are planning to take Lundy, Saunton and Exmoor Classes on a field trip to Exmoor. The children will be outside all day learning about the locality and wildlife.

Your child will need to wear an old t-shirt and a jumper (as it can be a lot cooler on Exmoor), with trousers or leggings. Please do not send them in jeans as these are very uncomfortable if they get wet. Also they will need to wear comfortable sturdy footwear as we will be walking on rough terrain. Please provide your child with a waterproof coat and trousers in case of rain. Also your child will need a backpack to carry their lunch and water bottle in.

A packed lunch, snack and water bottle will be needed as we are out all day. If you would like the school to provide a packed lunch for your child please contact the office **by Tuesday 28th September**.
