This week we have...

- Learn to retell the story of the Owl Babies by acting it out using our story telling spoons.
- Learnt the sounds h b l ll and have written and read CVC words using these sounds. We learnt some more 'tricky words' (words we can't sound out) **go** and **no**.
- Explored light, dark and shadows using torches in our dark den.
- Explored mark making using feathers and paint.
- Learn how to roll and trap a ball in PE
- Use junk modelling and collage materials to create owl puppets to retell the story.
- Found lots of different ways of making 4 using the part, park, whole method.
