As well as the work outlined below, there are past [SATs papers](#) from previous years on the government website.

PLEASE NOTE: We often leave the Spag test revision until about now so we have not yet covered this revision in the way we would normally have done, so *the use of past Spag papers should be considered essential*. These are the revision materials we are sending home:

READING:

- The CGP booklet called 'Targeted Questions'. Do the last 4 sections (we have done the others previously). No timings are given in this booklet so stick to the usual rule: 17 marks = 1/3 of a SATs test = about 20 mins for the first 17 marks...then finish any left-over questions.
- Photocopies from other CGP texts: Do the 3 units we have given you - a Fiction, poetry and non-fiction text.

MATHS:

- CGP Maths SATs Booster 10-minute Tests
- Any SATs past papers online - start with last year and work back.
Don't forget - stick to the timings (Paper 1 = 30 mins Paper 2 = 40mins
Paper 3 = 40mins)
- MyMaths... Measurement...Y5 Measuring lengths
Measurement...Y5 Units of length
Measurement...Y5 Units of mass
Measurement...Y5 Scale drawing
Measurement...Y5 Units of capacity

PLUS...any MyMaths units you didn't do from past homelearning.
