## Tarka Class - Home learning week ending 1<sup>st</sup> October

Tarka class enjoyed our trip to church on Tuesday to celebrate our Harvest Festival (even if the walk was a bit soggy). We talked about how and why we show respect in a church. The children really took this on board and behaved excellently. In English this week, we have focussed on using consistent finger spaces and full stops in our writing. We have explored the meaning of some of the trickier vocabulary in our text, using facial expressions and freeze frames to help with this.

In maths, the children have started to familiarise with the dienes/Base 10 equipment through play. We used the equipment to learn about the place value of numbers beyond 20.

Home learning: For our DT learning, we have tasted and evaluated different types of bread. The children designed their own bread roll this week, thinking about the ingredients we will need. Can you find out why we need yeast to make bread? What is yeast and why is it such an important ingredient?
