## Barum Class - Home learning week ending 16<sup>th</sup> September

This week in English we started our new text 'Cars and Trucks' by Neil Clark. In this sequence the children will produce a page for a fact book about plants. They will be learning about how to layout a non-fiction text using correct punctuation, compound sentences, questions and statements and write in the correct tense.

In maths this week we have been partitioning two-digit numbers into tens and ones and understanding what each digit in a two-digit number represents.

We started to talk about our topic Discovering Britain. The children thought about places in the UK that they have visited and we looked at the flags and flowers that represent England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
