This week we have:

- Been artists with Mrs Paul - learning how to create a self-portrait for our reports.
- Looked at different materials; wood, plastic, metal etc. and made a tally of how many items of each material we could spot in our classroom and around school. We realised how much plastic there is in our garden so we had a big tidy up with Christine, collecting all of the plastic and deciding whether we needed it or not!
- Read some stories about Plastic Pollution in the Ocean. *Marli's Tangled Tale* and *Nelson's Dangerous Dive* by Ellie Jackson and Laura Callwood. See if your child can tell you about them...
- Used estimation to see how many spaces the bee bots needed to travel to get to the end of our maze.
- Completed some observation forms about the insects we've found in the garden... the children have made a great home for them!
