

Home learning week 24

This week we have:

- Written a sentence about the story Jack and the Beanstalk. We have been trying to use interesting language in our sentences.
- Thought about measuring height in maths, using the language *short/shorter, tall/taller*. We measured the height of different beanstalks using cubes and ordered them from shortest to tallest.
- Talked about what 'science' means and explored the different uses of fruit, vegetables and flowers.
- Chopped up beetroot and made our own food colouring to dye some material. We also tested an onion dye that Barum class had made. The beetroot worked better as the colour was stronger.
- Had a fun afternoon experimenting with printing flowers and fruit onto bunting - the blackberries and daffodils worked the best!
- Learnt the phonemes **ear** and **ure** and tricky words **her** and **are** in phonics.
- Planted a bean to grow into our own beanstalk and cress to make cress heads!
