Parent Consultations

Illness

It can be upsetting when children seem fine but are unable to attend school due to sickness but we need to be extra vigilant at this time. If your child has been unwell at home with sickness and/or diarrhoea please keep your child off school for a minimum of 48 hours following the last episode of illness. If your child develops a temperature/cough/fever hot to touch/wheezing/tiredness alongside their illness then please contact NHS 111 and follow the advice given which may involve having a Coronavirus test. When your child returns to school we ask that they are well enough to be eating their normal diet.

Festive Fridays

If your child would like to join in with festive Friday then they may wear anything festive on any or all of the Friday's in December. We have changed the name from Christmas jumper day so no one feels they have to go out and buy a Christmas jumper. For example: wear a bauble pinned to a jumper, piece of tinsel in their hair, Christmas hat or a Christmas jumper if they already have one. Use anything Christmasy that you already have at home but suitable for a day in school and not too precious in case it gets damaged. (If your child usually has P.E on a Friday then they need to wear clothing appropriate for P.E.)
