



GEOGRAPHY

Weather and climate. Seasons. Comparing weather in our country to the Arctic.

RE

LITERACY

Instruction writing – linked to independence LP (Yr1 and 2)

Poetry – Yr1 *I Love Bugs* by Emma Dodd. Using adjectives and use of 'and'. Yr2 *The Sea Is...* by? Identifying nouns and adjectives; metaphors for description.

Story – Yr1 *It's My Birthday* – using 'and' to write a cumulative story. Yr 2 *Augustus and his Smile*. Conjunctions 'and', 'but', 'so'. Verbs – past tense.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION, DRAMA AND DANCE

MATHS

Number Sense

Yr 1: Sequencing events, days of the week, months of the year. Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Even and Odds.

Yr 2: Place Value – numbers up to 100. Recognising and using money. Comparing measures.

Addition and Subtraction

Yr1: using number lines to add and subtract. Solving one step and missing number problems.

Yr 2: Adding two-digit numbers-partitioning. Derive and use related facts to 100.

SCIENCE

Yr1: Weather and Seasons – observe and describe weather associated with seasons. Animals – identify and name a variety of common animals.
Yr2: Animals and Habitats – identify and name a variety of animals in their habitats.

COMPUTING

Use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private, identify where/who to go to for support.
