Illness

If your child has been unwell at home with sickness and/or diarrhoea please keep your child off school for a minimum of 48 hours following the last episode of illness. If your child develops a temperature/cough/fever hot to touch/wheezing/tiredness alongside their illness then please contact [NHS 111](#) and follow the advice given which may involve having a Coronavirus test. When your child returns to school we ask that they are well enough to be eating their normal diet.
