Very well done to our pupils: Elsie and Bessie: Yrs 3-4 and Bryony: Yrs 5-6 The girls all did really well, with Elsie coming 5th and Bessie coming 8th within their age group (out of 34) Bryony came 9th in her age group out of 28 with the top 10 being very close on scores. Well done girls! As a school we did well considering we were outnumbered by the other schools.
