Dear Parents/carers,

This week the Year 6 children have been to Junior Life skills where they have learned about keeping themselves and others safe. Today they have joined many other Year 6 groups at the Ocean Fest event in Croyde.

Ventrus: You may recall our consultation process to convert to Ventrus Multi Academy Trust that began last May (documents on our website)

Following the thorough due diligence process the Governors have decided that converting at this point would not be the best for our school, they have decided to evaluate the situation and consider our options over the next year or so. Remaining a maintained school will allow us flexibility with our staffing and budget that will contribute to meeting our current priorities. One of which is the Governors aim to provide additional space for the pre-school to join the school site, we very much hope that this will be possible; subject to planning permission. We aim to continue to work in partnership with Ventrus and are not considering other MATS at this point.

Age range consultation: The school is consulting to change the age range form 4-11 to 2-11; the documents regarding this are available on our website.

Attendance

Our overall school attendance is 94.8%, this is well below national average. Please note our attendance <u>policy</u> points below: Holidays may only be agreed in the following circumstances:

- There are exceptional circumstances as to why the holiday cannot be taken during term time and
- The child's attendance rate is over 96% in the current year (except where a child has had a significant period of illness with medical involvement)
- Permission is sought in advance.
- The dates do not fall during SATS week in KS2 or the first three weeks of any term
- *Parental time off work is not considered an exceptional reason

We will have to issue fines in order to improve our overall attendance percentage. Please take the time to consider this if you are planning future trips
