What a lovely sunny week it's been! The children have loved being on the field at lunchtime 😊

This week we have:

- Read and learnt about the story *My Friend Whale*. We made a story map and had a go at re-telling the story.
- Learnt some facts about Blue Whales - ask your child to tell you something they've found out.
- Talked about the difference between words and sounds in phonics. We've also thought about what a sentence needs (to make sense, finger spaces, a capital letter and full stop).
- Taken our 'mini me' pictures on adventures in the classroom and garden... making a park for them and building them a Lego house.
- Learnt how to make a wormery using recycled plastic bottles in Forest School. Some children made their own in our garden.
- Voted for the sea creature we want to learn about next week - Dolphins and Sharks were the winners!
